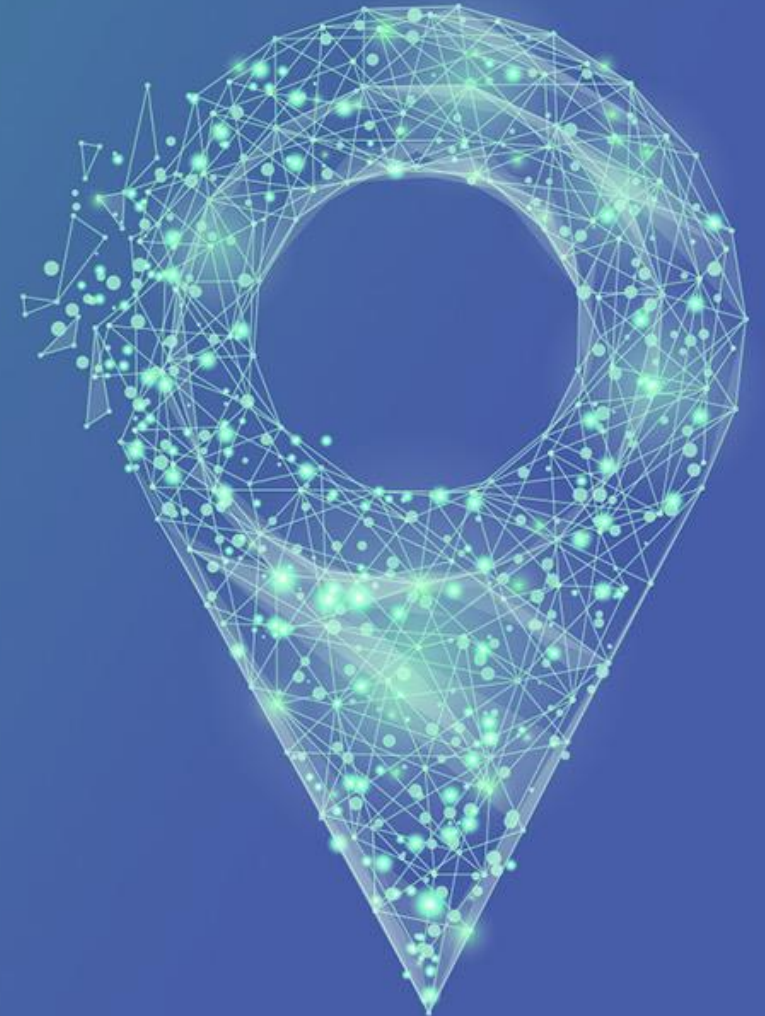

## Purpose of Pan-UK Data Governance Steering Group



Difficulties in obtaining access to data is a major blocker to research productivity



### Output

Streamlined data governance to facilitate faster & predictable access to data in TRES

## Action Forces



### TRE Legal Toolkit

Define roles and responsibilities between data custodians, data processors and researchers. Create flexible templates.



### Mapping

Create a single map of ethics and governance approvals needed to access data.



### Five Safes Form

Support adoption of Five Safes Form for data access and understand the current challenges in adoptions.

Create training to support data access request forms.

# Mapping Action Force



## Process mapping

### Single map of all ethics and governance approvals needed to link data:

- Four nations;
- Ethics, confidentiality and governance approvals;
- Key administrative data (e.g. ONS TRE) and health data;
- Links to application forms/processes and guidance



### Benefits:

- Beneficial to researchers to help them navigate the process.
- Enable the Steering Group to “visualise” the steps in the access process and the interplay between different types of approvals.
